Inclusivity: Include everyone in activities and be welcoming to new members. Celebrate diversity and practice empathy.

Focus: Pay attention as best you can during rehearsals and classes. Avoid distractions and stay engaged in the activities. Fidget toys are welcome, as needed.

Honesty: Be truthful in your interactions. Own up to mistakes and learn from them.

Communication: Express yourself clearly and respectfully. If you have concerns or problems, talk to a director or trusted adult.

Fun: Enjoy your time in Theatretrix! Embrace the joy of performing and the magic of theatre.

Consequences for Not Following the Code of Conduct

First Time: Verbal warning and reminder of expectations.

Second Time: Temporary removal from the activity and discussion with a director.

Third Time: Meeting with parents/guardians to discuss possible further action.
